Cash-back with Rotating Categories

• Chase Freedom® - 5% cash back up to a spending cap in multiple categories that rotate quarterly; rewards points can be combined in a single pot if you happen to have other Chase cards that operate on the Ultimate Rewards® system

Cash-back with Cardholder's Choice Rewards

• Bank of America® Cash Rewards - no annual fee and an option to choose the top rewards category on spending up to a quarterly cap; solid rewards for everyday spending beyond the top category and the opportunity to up cash back earning by 25%-75% more on each purchase as a Preferred Rewards member.

Best Cash-back Credit Cards for Small Businesses

• Ink Business Cash[™] Credit Card - offers up to 5% cash back in popular business categories (up to a spending cap) with no annual fee

Best Cash-back Credit Cards with no Foreign Transaction Fees

• Capital One® Quicksilver® Cash Rewards Credit Card - a rare cash-back rewards card that doesn't hit cardholders with fees (usually in the 3% range) each time it's used while traveling abroad; offers a flat-rate cash-back rewards rate

Best Cash-back Credit Cards for Fair Credit

• Capital One® QuicksilverOne® Cash Rewards Credit Card - available to those with average, fair or limited credit; offers a solid percentage of cash back for a modest annual fee

Best Cash-back Credit Cards for Bad or Limited Credit

• Credit One Bank® Unsecured Platinum Visa® - no need for a hefty security deposit; offers the opportunity to earn cash-back rewards in the form of statement credit

Best Cash-back Credit Cards for Students

• Journey® Student Rewards from Capital One® - a great card to build credit and earn rewards; it rewards good behavior to help new cardholders develop healthy, lifelong financial habits and offers text alerts and email reminders to help keep track of spending
